- All uniforms purchased are done according to the uniform rotation schedule with some variation depending upon expressed need of uniforms from season to season.
- Total number of contests is based on the total number of allowable games as determined by the PIAA/WPIAL. Furthermore, the number of contests played is based on multiple factors, such as but not limited to: weather, availability of opponents, field conditions/availability, number of students available to participate in the event safely and coaches' requests.
- The athletic department makes every effort to reschedule all cancelled games for both male and female teams, however, due to factors as stated above, may result in some games not being made up.
- Booster organization provide various athletic teams that they support the "extras" that the school does not provide for example: (travel warm-ups
