# Fox Chapel Area Schools Sports Hall of Fame Fall Sports Update

This fall Fox Chapel Athletes again excelled on the field and in the classroom. Three Fox Chapel teams finished as WPIAL Champion or WPIAL Runner-up. Here are the highlights...

- Field Hockey WPIAL Champions. Finished the regular season as co-section champions. Defeated North Allegheny 1-0 in the WPIAL Semi-finals before defeating Penn Trafford 1-0 in overtime to win the WPIAL Championship.
- Girls Volleyball WPIAL Runner-up. Defeated North Allegheny in a five set thriller in the WPIAL Semi-finals before falling to Peters Township in the WPIAL Championship.
- Boys Cross Country WPIAL Runner-up. Completed the regular season as undefeated section champion before finishing second at the WPIAL finals. Junior Ethan Martin placed second at WPIALS and was followed closely by junior Colin Martin in fifth to pace the team. Ethan went on to finish fifth and Colin sixteenth while the team finished twelfth at the PIAA Championships.
- Boys Golf Finished another strong season as the undefeated section champion. Juniors Jordan Alfery and Charlie Friend each shot 77 to share the medalist honors at the section tournament.
- Soccer Both the boys and girls soccer programs finished as section runnner-up and advanced to the WPIAL playoffs. The boys earned a victory in round one before falling 1-0 to eventual PIAA Champion Upper St Clair in round two. The girls season ended with a first round loss to Hampton.
- Girls Tennis Finished the regular season as section runner-up. Won their first round playoff matchup over Oakland Catholic before falling to North Allegheny in round two. Freshman Laurel Shymansky defeated fellow freshman Lacey Cohen for the section singles title.
- Girls Golf Senior Ashley DeMoss earned a spot in the WPIAL Championships where she finished seventh.
- Three Fox Chapel Area athletes have accepted partial scholarships to compete at NCAA Division 1 programs next fall. Elly Wagner will play softball for the University of North Carolina- Chapel Hill, Natalie Bonaroti will compete in lacrosse at Marist College and Ashley DeMoss will play golf for Marshall University.

#### NOMINATIONS NEEDED

Each January, the Hall of Fame considers and selects inductees to honor at the spring banquet. Athletes, who are ten years removed from Fox Chapel, are selected based on their contributions to athletics at Fox Chapel and beyond.

### ATHLETIC FACILITY UPGRADES

Thanks to the generosity of two private donors and the supplemental support of other athletic groups, a number of Fox Chapel facilities have been renovated.

Last spring the baseball field was upgraded with a synthetic surface on the infield. This is the same surface used at the University of Pittsburgh and will allow for all weather play. The softball field was given the same surface over the summer to assist the girl's program.

Additionally a second turfgrass field was installed behind Burke Stadium to allow football, soccer, field hockey, and lacrosse amongst others a practice facility that is not dependent on weather conditions.

The Hall of Fame continues to offer its support to the district through the purchase of equipment for all teams and by contributing to these improved facilites.
