### **Fall Sports**

A fall sports season that saw a number of outstanding team and individual performances this year.

Here are the highlights...

- **Girls Cross Country** Finished 9-0 as section champions. Earned their third consecutive trip to PIAA finals, where they finished fifth in state, by earning a top three finish at the WPIAL Championship meet. Senior Sarena Seager finished as WPIAL runner-up while Junior Grace Sisson finished 4th. Sarena finished her high school career with a 5th place finish at the PIAA meet while Grace finished 9th.
- **Boys Cross Country** 8-1 section runner-up. The boys finished 5th in the WPIAL led by Junior Christian Fitch's 3rd place individual finish. Christian went to his third PIAA finals where he finished 5th.
- **Girls Golf** Undefeated section champions. 5th place in the WPIAL. A mix of experience and young talent led the Foxes to an undefeated section season including two victories over rival Shadyside Academy.
- **Boys Golf** Section co-champs; WPIAL Runner-up; Senior Gregor Meyer, 5th; Junior Scott Bitar 6th; and Sophomore Aidan Oehrle 7th at the WPIAL finals. Gregor Meyer earned a 5th place finish at the PIAA finals with a 1 under par 70 in the second round.
- **Girls Tennis** Finished as section runner-up with a record of 8-1. Senior Kristen Friday finished third in the section singles tournament. Baylin Bitar and Katie Voight finished third in section doubles. Kristen Friday also received the U.S. Congressional Award for public service, self-reliance, physical fitness and personal development..
- **Boys Soccer** Boys soccer finished the section season at 8-5-1 to earn a WPIAL playoff berth. Juniors Josh Miller and Zane Ingram earned first team all section honors while Senior Alex Marotte and Junior Tommy Tsai earned second team honors and junior David Shin was named honorable mention.

All section honors were attained by Sam Brown, Korey Simmons, Ryan Billings, Shane Susnak and Alex Wecht in football, by Maura Curry and Kate Feczko in soccer, and by Jess Klein and Jessie Michel in volleyball.

## SCHOLARSHIP NEWS

Beginning in January, applications for the three scholarships awarded at the June Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony will be available in the high school guidance department.

- Fuhrer Family Scholarship is awarded to a Fox Chapel Area athlete who has demonstrated athletic and academic achievement along with financial need. The athlete chosen will be awarded 2,500 dollars a year, renewable for four years based on academic merit. Applicants need not plan on participating in college athletics to be eligible.
- Rich Kriston Scholarship was established to honor a Fox Chapel Area High School senior who has excelled in athletic activity while maintaining high sportsmanship standards. The scholarship is a one-time award of \$1,000 for a Fox Chapel Area High School Senior who has shown a commitment to continuing his/her education beyond high school.
- Ed Boyle Scholarship is named for the beloved physical education teacher and coach who initiated the Fox Chapel Area SchoolDistrict soccer program. This is a one-time award for a Fox Chapel Area soccer player who has exemplified the spirit and talents of Coach Boyle.
