• Tom Frost '83. Football, wrestling, track. Captain of football and wrestling. Earned four letters in football and golf at CMU. Two-time All Conference in football. DIII Academic All American in 1986.

• John Hribar '88. Volleyball. All WPIAL, All State. Team Captain at Stanford University. Two time NCAA team finalist. Honorable Mention All American. Played Professional Beach Volleyball.

• Marco Patitucci '91. Soccer. Three year starter, Two time All WPIAL, All State. Member of 1990 PIAA team champions. Three year starter at Robert Morris, three year all conference selection. Played in two NCAA tournaments. 1st round selection of NPSL.

• Dana Rofey '96. Soccer. Three time all section, twice All WPIAL. Hold FC records for shutouts in a season and career. Career record of 56 wins, 9 losses and 1 tie with a .57 GAA. Team Captain at Bucknell University.

• Bob Gerhart, Coach, Boys Tennis. Record of 268-82. Six time WPIAL Runner-up. Six WPIAL section titles. Coached PIAA Champions in singles and doubles and six WPIAL singles/ doubles champions.

• Harry Lodge, Aspinwall '51. Football and Basketball. Three year starter and Senior co-captian in football. Four year starter at North Carolina State, starting both ways in 1952. All Scholastic ACC award winner.

• Pierce Frauenheim, Aspinwall '58. Football and Basketball. Pgh Area Football All Star Game MVP. Three year letter winner and two year starter at Rutgers University. Varsity Football Coach at Immaculata HS in New Jersey. Led team to four state titles and 19 conference championships.

The winter sports season was again filled with successes.

The pool saw the Foxes complete another successful season. Junior JB Kolod finished third in diving at the WPIAL Championships and followed that up with a bronze medal performance at the PIAA Championships. Also at the PIAA Championships, junior Stanley Wang set a school record in the 100 meter breaststroke.

The wrestling team completed its dual meet season with a record of nineteen wins and thirteen losses and qualified for hte WPIAL Team Championship. Seniors Dave DiBenedetto and Carson Brooks both earned section championship honors. At the WPIAL Championship Carson placed third earning him a trip to the PIAA Finals. The girls' basketball team finished the regular season with a section record of 10 wins and 2 losses and an overall record of 17 wins and 3 losses. The team defeated Norwin in the WPIAL playoffs before falling to Mt. Lebanon in the WPIAL quarterfinals. In the PIAA tournament the girls defeated Holidaysburg before once again falling to Mt. Lebanon.

The boys' basketball team qualified for WPIAL playoffs for the fourth consecutive year. The team finished the season by losing to Shaler in the opening round of the WPIAL playoffs.

The winter sports season saw all five varsity sports qualify for the WPIAL playoffs or championships.
