• Debbie Shearer '79. 12 varsity letters in four sports volleyball, tennis, basketball & softball at Fox Chapel. 4 varsity letters in basketball and 2 in softball at IUP.

• Chris McKee '85. Football and Track, 6 varsity letters. 3 time football all conference. Lettered in football as a freshman at Georgia Tech, earned starting position on offensive line as a sophomore before career ending injury.

• Ann Zimmer '86. Soccer. 4 year varsity starter, 3 time All-WPIAL selection. '85 WPIAL Champion. Earned 3 varsity letters in soccer at the University of Virginia. ACC Student-athlete Academic Honor Roll 1987-1988.

• Erik Nelson '94. Basketball, 3 varsity letters. All section. University of Vermont basketball. America East All-Rookie Team, Two-time All America East Conference First Team. Ranks in the top five of four statistical categories at Vermont. Played professional basketball in Europe for 11 seasons earning multiple all-star appearances and three Netherlands Championships.

• Michael Frank 'oo. Earned 9 varsity letters in wrestling, football and baseball. Allconference football, section champion and Academic All State in wrestling. Wrestling Captain at Duquesne University, Academic All-American, Conference Champion, NCAA Division I Championship Qualifier.
