- David Borland '87. Soccer, Basketball. Fouryear starter and letter winner in soccer, one-year starter, two varsity letters in basketball. All-WPIAL in soccer as a senior. Four-year starter at Alfred University. All-Conference and Regional All-American honors.
- Joe O'Donnell '92. Football, Soccer, Track. Two year letter winner in football, All-Conference kicker as a senior. First team kicker at Tennessee Martin as freshman before transferring to Maryland as a sophomore. First team kicker at Maryland 94-96 where he earned honorable mention All ACC honors. Kicked in Arena Football and spent time in NFL with Steelers, Raiders, and Bears. Four year starter in soccer, including on the 1990 PIAA Champions and 1991 WPIAL Champions. All-WPIAL soccer.
- Sarah (Prentiss) Brown '97. Swimming, Field Hockey, Track and Field. Four-year letter winner in all three sports. In swimming was a four-time All-American, co-captain of the 1996 WPIAL Champion and 1997 PIAA runner-up teams. FC record holder in 200 medley relay and freestyle relay. WPIAL qualifier in high jump and 4x100 relay. Co-captain field hockey. Swam four years at Univ. of New Hampshire where she was record holder in two events and an Academic All-American.

- Tim Sasson '98. Track and Field, Football. Fouryear letter winner in track and field at FC. School record holder and bronze medal in shot put at WPIAL finals, PIAA qualifier. Three year starter and letter winner in football. Named All-Conference and All-State defensive tackle as senior. Caption of Conference Champion and WPIAL semifinalist team. Lettered at IUP before back injury ended playing career. Currently Offensive Coordinator at PIAA Champion Pine Richland.
- Heather (Rice) Alsabagh '98. Soccer. Four-year letter winner and starter. Played in 1 WPIAL Championship, 3 WPIAL and 3 PIAA Final Fours. Named All-WPIAL 3 times, All-PIAA 2 times, Regional All-American 2 times, National All-American as a senior. Tribune Review and Post Gazette Player of the Year as senior. 4 year starter and 2 time conference Player of the Year at Franklin and Marshall. Played for the Israeli National Team in 2002. Inducted into the Western PA Jewish Sports Hall of Fame.
