The Sports Hall of Fame is honored to announce the class of 2019. The Induction Ceremony and Banquet will be held on Saturday, June 8th at the Harmar House, Cheswick.

- **Molly (Linhart) Campbell '06.** Soccer and Track. Earned 8 varsity letters. Leading scorer and All-Section soccer selection as a junior and senior. Two-time WPIAL finalist and one-time PIAA qualifier in 800 meters. Bucknell University soccer. Co-captain as a senior. Two-time team Patriot League Champions, one-time Patriot League All Tournament Team.
- **Dann Kabala '97.** Football and Track. Earned 9 varsity letters (3 football, 3 track, 2 basketball, 1 baseball). All-Conference WR as a senior. Senior captain of football who lead team to first playoff berth in 13 years. As freshman at Johns Hopkins finished in top 10 in NCAA DIII for kick return yardage. Football Operations Assistant, Jacksonville Jaguars ('99-'00), Football staff member at the University of Pittsburgh and University of Arkansas. Currently the Director of High School Relations for Penn State Football.
- **Doug Ostrosky '94.** Football and Basketball. Earned 8 varsity letters in football and basketball. Twice named to Post Gazette Fabulous 22, All State Football. Career 1000 point scorer for FC Basketball. Played quarterback and tight end at Penn State lettering in 1997.
- **CJ Patrick '95.** Ice Hockey. Earned 4 varsity letters in hockey. Three year team captain. Four-time WPIHL All-Star. Post Gazette Stellar Six selection following 51 goals & 29 assist in a 25 game season as a senior. Penn State Hockey, two year team captain. 1998 ACHA National Champions, 1999 ACHA Runner-up. 37 goals and 45 assists in 95 games at Penn State.
- **Tracy (Sullivan) Slater '92.** Volleyball and Basketball. Earned 8 varsity letters in volleyball and basketball. Two-time team captain volleyball, one year captain in basketball. Section champion and WPIAL finalist in volleyball as a sophomore. Point Park College volleyball and basketball. Four year starter and three year captain in volleyball. Two year starter and captain in basketball. NAIA D1 playoff qualifier for four years.

Winter Sports Update

Swimming/Diving

5-1 section, 9-2 overall, Section Runner-up

Freshman Zoe Skirboll finished a record setting freshman season by winning the 200IM title at the PIAA Championships and finishing 2nd in the 100 breaststroke. Zoe won the 100 breaststroke at the WPIAL finals and set a WPIAL record. She also set four new school records over the course of the season. Zoe was joined at the PIAA Championships by Grace Gackebach, Vivian Shao and Leia Ross. The girls team earned a top five WPIAL team finish.

Senior Jonah Cagley earned his second WPIAL diving title and a 5th place finish at the PIAA Championships. Sophomore David Manelis finished 4th at the WPIALs and runner-up at the PIAA Championships.

The boys team had five individual qualifiers and two relay teams earn spots in the pool at the WPIAL finals.

Boys' Basketball

8-2 section/16-9 overall, Section Runner-up.

Advanced to the WPIAL and PIAA 6A playoffs. Earned back to back PIAA berths for the first time in program history. Senior Ryan Kerr and Juniors Sam Brown and Arnold Vento earned all section honors.

Girls' Basketball

8-6 section/15-9 overall

The girls bounced back from a tough '17-'18 season to earn WPIAL and PIAAA playoff berths. Gabby Guerrieri was named second team all section while Domenica Delaney and Ellie Schwartzman were honorable mention all section choices.

Wrestling

2-3 section/8-9 overall

The Foxes had six wrestlers qualify for the WPIAL championships. Junior Eddie Farrell finished top 8 in the WPIAL. Senior Jordana Matamoros became the first female to medal in the Allegheny County wrestling tournament history. She went on to finish as a finalist at the girls' state wrestling championships.

Indoor Track

Girls earned a 2nd place and boys a 3rd place finish out of 75 teams competing at the TCTSA winter championships.

The girls team was led by Kate Carnevale who captured 1st place in the 60 meter and 200 meter championship. The girls medley relay (Kate Carnevale, Brooke Krally and Sarena Seeger and Grace Sisson) finished 1st as well. Grace Sisson (3rd) and Sarena Seeger (7th) earned podium spots in the mile.

The boys were led by Christian Fitch who placed 2nd in the 3000 meters and Korey Simmons, 4th in the 60 meter hurdles. The 4x400 relay team earned a 6th place finish and the 4x200 really finished 7th to earn podium spots for the Foxes.

Gymnastics

Finished the season 1-8. Six gymnasts (Hannah Essey, Claire Hamilton, Rachel Himmel, Audrey Mah, Lucy Markowitz, Michael Nicholas) qualified for the WPIAL finals.
