# Fox Chapel Area Schools Sports Hall of Fame

## Fall Sports Update

Another busy fall sports season has ended for the Foxes. Here are the highlights...

- **Boys Cross Country** - 8-0, Section Champions. The boys raced to their fourth consecutive section title and finished in the top 10 at the WPIAL Championships. Sophomores Rowan Gwin finished 6th and Ethan Vaughn 14th at the WPIAL Championships to advance to the PIAA finals.
- **Girls Cross Country** - 6-1 Section runner-up. Clara Kelly, Marin Airik & Emily Harajda all finished in the top 10 at sectionals.
- **Boys Golf** - Section Champions. Boys Golf continued their run of section championships before falling in the WPIAL semifinals. Junior David Fuhrer tied for the section individual title and advanced along with Davis Kittsley, Joey Rattner, and Andrew Begg to the WPIAL Individual Finals. Fuhrer went on to finish 17th in the individual competition.
- **Girls Golf** - 9-1. Section Champions, WPIAL Finalist. The girls golf team captured their fifth consecutive section title during the regular season and went on to a fifth place finish at the WPIAL Championships. Laila Golla earned a spot in the WPIAL Individual Championships finishing 22nd in her first attempt.
- **Field Hockey** - 10-7-1, 4-3-1. Seniors Caroline Bonidy, Ally Drum and Aly Solomon were returning WPIAL Field Hockey All-Stars who led the team to the WPIAL Semifinals. After a hard fought game the team lost to Latrobe in overtime.
- **Girls Tennis** - 8-5, 7-1. Section runner-up. The team swept Moon in the opening round of the WPIAL playoffs before falling to eventual WPIAL Champions Mt. Lebanon in the quarterfinals. Sophomore Sienna Siegal and Freshman Chanel Brun finished as section doubles runner-up and advanced to WPIALs where they won two matches before falling in the semifinals.
- **Boys Soccer** - 11-3-2, 10-2-2. Boys soccer finished the section season as runner-up. The team stormed past Canon-McMillan 5-0 in the WPIAL quarterfinals before falling 3-2 to Seneca Valley in the WPIAL semis. Colin Westerberg, George Tabor, John Paul Brach, and Colin Lazzara earned WPSCA All-Section honors. Westerberg was also named WPSCA All-State.
- **Girls Soccer** - 8-8-2, 6-6-2. The girls streak of 17 straight playoff appearances ended after a .500 season. Senior Makayla Mulholland and Juniors Kate Friday and Anna Troutman were named All-WPIAL players.

### NOMINATIONS NEEDED

Each January, the Hall of Fame considers and selects inductees to honor at the spring banquet. Athletes, who are ten years removed from Fox Chapel, are selected based on their contributions to athletics at Fox Chapel and beyond.

The Hall of Fame Committee is surprised each year by the number of outstanding candidates that have never been nominated for consideration.

## SCHOLARSHIP NEWS

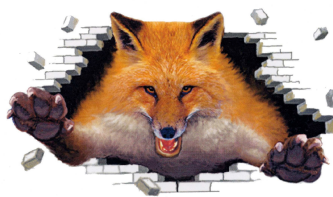
Beginning in January, applications for the three scholarships awarded at the June Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony. These scholarship applications will be available in the FCAHS Guidance Department; completed applications should be returned by April 14, 2023.

- **The Fuhrer Family Scholarship** is awarded to a Fox Chapel Area athlete who has demonstrated athletic and academic achievement along with financial need. The athlete chosen will be awarded 2,500 dollars a year, renewable for four years based on academic merit. Applicants need not plan on participating in college athletics to be eligible.
- **The Lodge Family Scholarship** was created to honor a Fox Chapel High School senior who has excelled in their chosen athletic activity, maintained high academic standards, and shown a commitment to community service. The scholarship is a one time award of \$3500 for a senior who is continuing her/his education beyond high school.
- **The Ed Boyle Scholarship** is named for former FCAHS physical education teacher and coach who initiated the Fox Chapel Area School District soccer program. This is a one-time award for a Fox Chapel Area soccer player who has exemplified the spirit and talents of Coach Boyle. Application and information for this award may be found through the Pittsburgh Foundation. Completed application should be returned via the Pittsburgh Foundation website.
